The Youngstown Playhouse, founded in 1924, has sustained a legacy of quality live performance theatre in Northeast Ohio by staging innovative, unique, and accessible theatrical performances of both classic and modern productions. Located in Youngstown's Glenwood Avenue Corridor, the Youngstown Playhouse annually serves over 9,000 guests of all ages with a full season of musicals and plays complemented by workshops, readings, and concerts. The Playhouse facility houses a mainstage theatre of 400 seats and The Moyer Room an intimate blackbox space seating 75. The Youth Theatre Program serves nearly 150 participants through classes, workshops, and fully staged productions attended by over 1,000 local public school students annually. 


