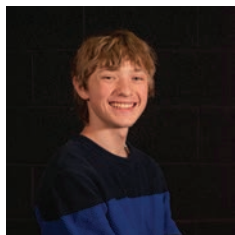

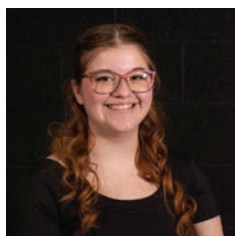
## ARTIST PROFILES
